Training in Chimoio, Mozambique

In January Ulrike and I, together with the Superintendent for Central Africa, Charles Karangwa, were privileged to conduct a training seminar in Chimoio, Mozambique, under the leadership of the National Overseer Armindo Magule. A total of 101 pastors & leaders attended. Most of the participants were church planters. In recent years 345 churches were planted in this area of Mozambique alone, hence the need for leadership development is overwhelming.

New Bible School in Luanda, Angola

In March, Charles Karangwa and I visited the Church of God World Missions in Angola which is led by Rufino Higino. We were able to train national leaders, attend a Firewall graduation and visit a newly established Portuguese-speaking Bible School, which was begun by the Brazilian Missionary Kilanny Queiroz under the umbrella of the Brazilian Seminário Evangélico da Igreja de Deus (SEID). Arlindo Chandama, national Youth Director and current MA student is assisting in teaching and facilitating the training.

Visiting new Bible School in Angola

Berea Theological University College - this is the name of our Central Africa Bible College situated in Lusaka, Zambia. September 1, 2020 marked the day when Dr. Scott Rains was inaugurated as new Director.

For close to two years the Bible College was under the interim leadership of Dr. Paul Stockard following the untimely passing of the previous director Rodney Friend to eternal glory.

The Zambia Higher Education Authority made an accreditation site visit September 3 - 4 and looked at all aspects of the Bible College. The goal is to offer an accredited Bachelor degree in the following three areas, i.e., in Theology, Leadership, and Chaplaincy.

Master Program

During the Covid-19 lockdown the Master Program for Africa met for one class using online technologies. Dr. Ayuk Ayuk taught *Social Transformation and Community Development*. Some students coined this the best subject so far in the entire program! It is exciting to see how the program is bearing fruit and how students - who are all in their respective ministries - gain a deeper understanding of what they have learned, applying it to the church and the community at large.

As I am writing these lines, preparations are underway to have the next on-site module scheduled for the last two weeks of November 2020 in Lusaka, Zambia. We are praying that we shall be able to meet with the student body from across Africa.

2.237 students are currently enrolled in the 20 Bible Schools and training programs of the Church of God in Africa. Most of the students are already actively involved in ministry and desire for ministerial development, training and education (figures are as of September 2020).
